

How will COVID-19 affect ECON 3010 for the remainder of the semester?

Q. How will the material change now that delivery is online and we lost one week?

A. I cut out two chapters and the epilogue. This is now reflected in the syllabus and lecture notes posted on our website. I also cut out material and streamlined the PowerPoint notes. The material in the lecture notes will be the primary content for the remaining exams, but you should still read the relevant chapters from the e-book.
